- Small power unit
- Statements / Word of Greeting
- Musical pieces / Jewish dances

Scenario 3: full day of action (example Tübingen)

10:00h – 18:00h: Sukkah on the market square with explanation of Sukkoth and activities for children and adults

18:00h: public March of solidarity from the former Synagogue to the market square

18:20h: public event with PA System

- Live music
- Dance
- Moderated introduction to the Day of Action
- Input on Sukkoth with regards to local Jewish life
- Word of Greeting of IRGW Württemberg (reading out or live)
- Reading of the collective declaration
- Forming a Star of David with 6 people (white and blue ribbons, 10 Meters)
- Concluding song

Ideas on how to form a Star of David

1. 6 Persons hold blue and white ribbons to form a Star of David:

 - can be realized in different sizes, depending on local conditions
 - Photo can be taken from a tower or adjacent building, e.g. with a drone
2. Forming a Star of David with rocks on the ground
3. Drawing a Star of David with chalk on the ground
4. Human Star of David: the participants line up along markers (e.g. string) in the shape of a Star of David – paying attention to Corona regulated distancing!
5. If in darkness: Forming a Star of David with lights (e.g. glow sticks or LED candles)
